The recipients may use the academic based scholarship to attend any four-year college or university to cover the costs of books and/or other supplies for school.

Students competing for the Sigma Psi Omega Making Strides Scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Applicant must be a high school senior residing in Nassau or Suffolk County.
- Applicant must enroll in a full-time undergraduate program no later than the fall of their graduation from H.S.
- Applicant's parent or guardian has been affected by breast cancer.

Sigma Psi Omega Making Strides Selection Process:

- Applicant attained a Cumulative Grade Point Average of 85 or better.
- School and community involvement.
- Demonstrated leadership ability.
- Effective oral and written communication skills.

Notification to Applicants:

Applicant will be notified in May of their status. Checks will be distributed upon receipt of the students' proof of enrollment in an accredited institution in the fall of their graduation year.

Applications are due by final postmarked deadline of April 3, 2017
